The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.105 dated 02.02.2022 registered under Section 379-A of the IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal.

2. FIR was lodged on the complaint of Guddi as per which she was present in the street in front of her house on 02.02.2022 when two persons snatched ₹5,500/- from her hands and fled away. Later on, petitioner- Anurag @ Anu was arrested on 25.03.2022 and an amount of ₹500/- was recovered from him, based on his disclosure statement.

3. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has been falsely implicated and that he is in custody for the last

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more than one year.

4. Custody certificate along with reply by way of an affidavit of Shri Nayab Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Traffic Karnal has been filed on behalf of respondent- State.

5. As per the custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year 04 months and 25 days. Though he is involved in two more cases but considering the fact that he was not named in the FIR nor there was assertion in the FIR that complainant could identify the snatchers and considering the fact that an amount of ₹500/- only was recovered from the possession of the petitioner and that co-accused Karan has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 06.01.2023 in CRM-M-60507-2022 but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
