[1] Prayer in the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to grant furlough to the petitioner for four weeks in terms of Section 4 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release), Act, 2022.

[2] Learned Addl. A.G. has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Devi Dayal, Superintendent, District Jail, Panipat dated 19.08.2023 along with Annexures R/1 and R/2 dated 18.08.2023 (i.e. orders passed by the Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal granting furlough to the petitioner and copy of personal bonds of the petitioner sent to the District Magistrate, Panipat) respectively. The same are taken on record.

[3] None is present on behalf of the petitioner. However, in view of reply dated 19.08.2023 as well as orders of the Commissioner,
