The jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been invoked seeking directions to the official respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7 and their relatives with further prayer not to harass the petitioner and her landlord.

Learned State counsel submits that during inquiry, notices were issued to both the parties. Though the petitioner did not join the proceedings but sent her statements through e-mails on 07.09.2022 and 10.09.2022, stating that she has solemnized marriage at her own will and now she does not require any protection.

In view of statements made by the petitioner, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
