VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing necessary directions to respondent No.2 to personally look into the matter with respect to GD No.001 dated 26.07.2023, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, under Section 323, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC, in a cross case in FIR No.287 dated 25.07.2023, under Sections 341, 506, 427, 324, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the present petition is treated as representation and respondent No.2 is directed to look into the

same and takes an appropriate action in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.6 to 8 has filed a short reply and the same is taken on record. It is submitted that respondents No.6 to 8 be also heard by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur (respondent No.2) while considering the matter. It is also submitted that respondents No.6 to 8 have no objection in case respondent No.2 looks into the grievances of both the parties.

4. Learned State counsel has submitted that respondent No.2 would consider the grievances of both the parties and thereafter, take appropriate action in accordance with law.

5. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with the following terms: -

- (i) Respondent No.2 would consider the present petition as a representation and would consider the same as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
- (ii) It would be open to respondents No.6 to 8 to give a representation to respondent No.2 within a period of five days from today and in case of their doing so, respondent No.2 would also consider the same alongwith the present petition.
- (iii) Respondent No.2 would also give personally hearing to the petitioner as well as respondents No.6 to 8 and after considering the matter, respondent No.2 would take appropriate action in accordance with law.

6. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.2 would consider the pleas raised by contesting parties independently and would take appropriate action in accordance with law.
