1. This application is filed for amendment of the head note and prayer clause of the main petition and placing on record the amended copy of the petition.

2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed, amended copy of the petition is taken on record.

Main case

3. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in GD mentioned below:-

4. The brief facts are that an FIR and DDR was registered at the instance of both the parties involved in an incident which took place on 31st May, 2021. The petitioner-Hardev Singh is husband of

incident took place on 31st May, 2021. The petitioner was attributed a *datar* blow on the wrist of the Harjeet Kaur.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a version and cross-version of the incident. Petitioner is in custody since 26th April, 2023. The investigation is complete, no further recovery is to be made and petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

6. Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail.

7. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, having conspectus of the fact, considering the facts and circumstance that injury attributed to the petitioner in on non-vital part, though the investigation is complete, conclusion of trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

8. The petition is allowed.

9. Since the main case has been allowed, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
