1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though during the pendency of the present petition, vide notification dated 04.03.2014, the grade pay has been fixed at Rs.4200/- instead of Rs.3600/- as being claimed in the present petition but the benefits under the said notification have not been extended to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner files any representation claiming the benefit under the notification dated 04.03.2014, his claim will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case the claim of the petitioner is found to be genuine, the benefit will be released to him within a further period of four weeks.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file representation with the respondents.

4. Ordered accordingly.
