1. This is fourth petition filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 78, dated 14.8.2020, under Sections 22, 29 and 31 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act') registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

2. The main thrust for seeking regular bail is on the ground of custody period.

3. Learned State counsel submits that out of total twelve prosecution witnesses, nine have been examined, two were given up and an earnest effort would be made to examine the remaining prosecution witness within three weeks from the date fixed in the trial Court.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.

6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
7. Since the main case has been dismissed as withdrawn, the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
