Learned counsel for the petitioner has informed that with respect to the Assessment Year (AY) 2005-06, he had deposited 100% of the tax. With respect to AY-2006-07, copy of the order has not been supplied to him, however, he had deposited 25% of the tax before the Assessing Authority and he has got the duplicate C-Form; with respect to AY-2007-08, nothing is due and for the AY-2010-11, he has got the original C-Form which he shall produce before the authority within 04 days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that he has got original C-Form for the year 2010-2011 and counter C Forms for the year 2006-07. He shall produce both the documents before the authorities tomorrow for verification.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sumeet Goel, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent-U.T. Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that he shall provide the order of the Assessing Authority with respect to AY 2006-07 within a period of one week to the petitioner since the petitioner has already deposited 25% of the tax due before the Assessing Authority for the AY-2006-07 and further for the AY-2010-11 before the Appellate Authority.

A direction is given to the respondent to defreeze the account of the petitioner.

The present petition is disposed with aforesaid directions.
