The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.304 dated 29.10.2021 under Sections 420, 406, 506, 34 IPC (Sections 467, 468 and 471 were added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.09.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Rajinder Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 16.09.2022 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 16.09.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
