The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 22.07.2014 Annexure P-14 by which request of the petitioner for grant of special/additional ACP grade of Rs.5200-20200/- with grade pay of Rs.4000/- has been declined, with a further prayer to grant the petitioner the pay scale equivalent of respondent No.5-Brij Mohan son of Shri Chhote Lal.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 would submit that the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous considering the fact that approval has been granted to pay the petitioner the

same pay scales as that is payable to respondent No.5-Brij Mohan, Driver, vide office order dated 25.01.2023. A copy of said order is taken on record.

I have heard counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the pay of the petitioner stands refixed at par with that of Brij Mohan, Driver, the present writ petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Needless to say, on account of refixing of the pay scales, the arrears would be released from the day due till actual payment is made, within a period of two months, on receipt of certified copy of this order along with interest @ 7% per annum.
