The petitioner is seeking extension of his parole for a period of two weeks.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that 75 years old father of the petitioner is suffering from heart ailment. He has referred to the copy of the medical records of father of the petitioner at Annexure P-3. The petitioner has not misused the concession of parole at any point of time.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall surrender by 16.08.2023 and would not seek any further extension of parole.

5. Heard. In view of the ill-health of the father of the petitioner, the parole granted to the petitioner is extended till 16.08.2023. The petitioner shall surrender to the concerned Jail by 05:00 p.m. on 16.08.2023.
