1. The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.899 dated 04.08.2019 under Section 174-A of the IPC registered at Police Station City Jagadhri Yamuna Nagar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset does not press the instant petition. He submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court within one week. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Dismissed as not pressed.

4. However, the petitioner is directed to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within one week from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

5. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender

before the Trial Court within one week from today, this order shall be of no avail to him thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously, by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
