This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of letter dated 01.11.2017 vide which the prayer of the petitioner for further revaluation of Chemistry has been rejected.

Learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3 has submitted that there is no rule providing for revaluation and yet respondents no.2 and 3 on two occasions, as an exceptional case, had done revaluation and in both the situations, the marks of the petitioner in Chemistry subject have not increased and now the petitioner has prayed for revaluation for the third time.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner today. Even on 16.12.2022, 26.07.2022 and also on 27.02.2020, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
