Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.313 dated 01.08.2022, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323 & 506 of IPC (challan presented under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 and 324 IPC) at Police Station Ram Nagar Karnal, District Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 11.04.2023.

This Court vide order dated 21.08.2023 had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send his/her report qua

the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Karnal and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 21.09.2023 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

Statement of respondents No.2 and 3-complainants, namely, Anil Kumar alias Bunti Dheer and Akashveer alias Sonu with regard to compromise was recorded before learned Magistrate on 13.09.2023.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and F.I.R. No.313 dated 01.08.2022, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323 & 506 of IPC (challan presented under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 and 324 IPC) at Police Station Ram Nagar

Karnal, District Karnal and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise qua petitioner(s), are hereby quashed.
