1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 06.06.2022 (Anneuxre P-6) passed by respondent No. 3, (SDM, Jalandhar-II) under Sections 4, 5 and 24 of the Maintenance and Welfare of the Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007.
2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that as per the judgment of the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in Paramjit Kumar Saroya Vs. Union of India and another, reported as 2016(3) RCR (Civil) 146 an appeal under Section 16 of the Maintenance and Welfare of the Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 is maintainable before the appellate Authority. It has been further pointed out that in the present petition, it has been mentioned in para 18 that there is no other efficacious remedy.
3. Case has been called twice. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.
4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to move an application for restoration of the present petition or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
