Main case

This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to get the work completed of laying drains in the locality of the petitioner as per the terms of the tender allotted vide acceptance letter dated 21.08.2017 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner

would be satisfied in case, he is permitted to give a representation to respondent No.2 bringing out his grievance and in case, the same is considered by respondent No.2, in accordance with law.

On the other hand, learned counsel for respondent No.2 has submitted that the drains have been laid as per the terms of tender and the residents of the locality are satisfied with the same, but however, in case, the petitioner moves a representation before respondent No.2, then respondent No.2 would consider the same, in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move a representation before respondent No.2 within a period of two weeks from today detailing his grievances and respondent No.2 is directed to consider the same as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
