1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the letter dated 31.05.2017 (Annexure P-8) vide which benefit of pension on full salary under Employees Pension Scheme, 1995, stands denied to the members of exempted establishments.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 submits that the instant petition is covered by the judgment rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of '**The Employees Provident Fund Organization and Another Etc. Vs. Sunil Kumar B.**

and others Etc. 2022 (4) SCT 674’ and submits that the claims of the petitioners would be considered in accordance of the aforesaid judgment.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

5. Respondents No.2 & 3 shall consider the claim of the petitioners in the light of the judgment passed by the Hon’ble Supreme Court (supra).
