The present petition has been filed under Section 407 read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. seeking transfer of Criminal Complaint case No.NACT 6491 of 2020 dated 28.09.2020 titled as “Mohan Lal Vs. M/S Manchanda Agencies and another” (Annexure P-1) filed under Section 138/142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 pending in the Court of Ld. JM1C, Chandigarh to the Court of competent jurisdiction in District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners as well as the complainant are senior citizens, and residents of District Ambala. Hence, it would be convenient for both the parties, if the case in hand, is transferred to Ambala.
