The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case GD No.32 dated 17.05.2022, under Sections 307, 323, 427, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural in FIR No.67 dated 28.03.2019 under Sections 326, 324, 452, 427, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Lopoke, Amrtisar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.09.2022 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
