The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to transfer the inquiry in case bearing DDR No.36 dated 08.07.2020 at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur filed by the petitioner for the registration of an FIR under Sections 307, 326, 506 IPC against respondent Nos.6 to 8 to any police station outside District Sangrur.

The learned State counsel while referring to the reply dated 12.01.2021 contends that there is an FIR No.35 dated 01.03.2018 under Sections 365, 385, 342, 506, 148, 149 IPC which stands registered against the petitioner. The present complaint is merely a counter-blast to the aforementioned FIR. He, therefore, contends that the present petition ought to be dismissed.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Admittedly, a prior FIR stands registered against the petitioner. As per the Investigating Agency, the instant DDR is a counter-blast to the said FIR. The allegations in the DDR have been found to be incorrect.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

However, the petitioner is free to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with law.
