1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to take legal action in accordance with law against respondents No.4 to 6 upon a complaint moved by the petitioner.

2. Upon notice, reply was filed to the instant petition by the State by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ghanour, Patiala, District Patiala. Para No.8 of the reply reads as under:-

“That keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances as during the enquiry matter is found to be a land dispute, which is civil nature, therefore, the present petition is not maintainable and the same is deserved to be dismissed being devoid of any merits in the interest of justice.”

3. The above re-produced para reveals that upon enquiry, the complaint of the petitioner was found to be devoid of merits, therefore, no further action is required to be taken in the instant petition.

4. However, in case the petitioner has any grievance, he is at liberty to approach the appropriate Court for redressal of his grievance.

5. Dismissed with aforesaid liberty.
