LISA GILL, J.

1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant – wife challenging order dated 10.09.2021 whereby her application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act (for short – ‘the Act’) has been decided, to the extent that quantum of maintenance awarded to her is deficit.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant informs that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Terms and conditions of settlement were reduced in writing on 30.01.2023. Settlement/agreement dated 30.01.2023 is on record as Annexure A1.

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3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that statement of the parties at first motion under Section 13B of the Act filed by them has since been recorded and the matter is now listed for recording of statement of the parties at second motion.

4. Learned counsel submits that he has specific instructions from the appellant to withdraw the present appeal on account of settlement dated 30.01.2023, with liberty to the appellant to file an appropriate application in case terms and conditions of the settlement are not adhered to by the respondent.

5. Present appeal is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.

6. Pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of, accordingly.
