1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 to 6 to conduct proper inquiry regarding the amount of panchayat fund spent by respondent No.7.

2. On 03.05.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned State counsel has pointed that prayer in the present petition is for directing respondents No.2 to 6 to conduct proper enquiry with respect to the amount of panchayat fund spent by respondent No.7. He has further submitted that an enquiry has been conducted in the present

case and the embezzled amount along with interest has already been recovered from respondent No.7 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for an adjournment to get instructions in the matter.
