The instant writ petition had been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to not harass the petitioner by holding repeated enquiries on the applications given by respondent No.8 against the petitioner with similar set of allegations.

Affidavit dated 30.10.2020 has been filed by the Director General of Police, Punjab, wherein it has been stated that respondent No.8 had filed multiple complaints to various authorities in the State of Punjab and outside and enquiry was conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kotkapura, and the allegations levelled by respondent No.8 were not substantiated either on facts or the evidence. Accordingly, the complaints had been ordered to be filed. Further, the proceedings under Section 182 of the Indian Penal Code, have already been instituted against respondent No.8 for levelling false allegations against the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid written statement filed on behalf of the respondent-State, no further directions are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage.
