The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 9 and further direction has been sought to respondent No.4 not to interfere in the life of the petitioner at the behest of respondent Nos.5 to 9.

On issuance of notice of motion, learned State counsel has filed the status report/reply dated 24.05.2023 which is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner. In para No.9 of the status report it has been stated as under:-

"9. That the petitioner was arrested in the FIR in question on 15.06.2019 and now he is on bail. False allegations have been leveled against the police officials including the respondent No.4. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner against the answering respondents with some ulterior motives. There is no grain of truth in the allegations leveled by the petitioner against the police. There is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the respondents No.4 to 9 as revealed during the enquiry."

In view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
