DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (Oral)

1. On 10.10.2023, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.199, dated 09.03.2023, under Sections 20(b)(ii)(C), 20(b) 2C and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Allegations are that 2 Kg. 535 grams of charas was recovered from the possession of co-accused Bajrang @ Sunil, who nominated the petitioner to be the supplier.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated; that he is not involved in any such case; that he is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of paper

book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Learned State counsel while opposing the bail petition, has drawn attention towards the order dated 24.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Rohtak, wherein it is mentioned that involvement of the petitioner with the main accused was evident as he was having numerous calls with the main accused.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that no mobile number is mentioned and that mobile if any is in the name of the mother of the petitioner and not in the name of the petitioner. Learned counsel contends that he never used the mobile as referred in the aforesaid order.

Adjourned to 06.12.2023 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 10.10.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

3. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 10.10.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so
