Petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned award dated 30.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Ambala/respondent No.1, whereby his claim for reinstatement with full backwages was rejected.

Learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner had joined as Chowkidar in Government Girl School, Sajuma, District Kaithal on 01.06.2010 and was drawing salary of Rs.1000/-, but his services were terminated on 18.09.2014 by the respondent No.2 without giving him any notice. She submits that the juniors to the petitioner were retained and even fresh appointments were also made after his termination. She has contended that the claim of the workman seeking reinstatement with full backwages has been wrongly and illegally decided against the petitioner-workman by the Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Ambala, therefore, through this writ petition the petitioner-workman is seeking indulgence of this Court by invoking extra ordinary writ

jurisdiction under Article 226 Constitution of India.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the services of the petitioner were allegedly terminated on 18.09.2014 and the industrial dispute raised by him was decided through impugned award dated 30.03.2017, whereas the writ petition has been filed after a delay on 01.09.2022.

In view of above, this Court does not find any ground to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction under Article 226 Constitution of India, as the claim raised by the petitioner-workman suffers from delay and latches.

Dismissed.
