1. On 07.08.2023, the following order was passed:

“The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to renew his passport.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that petitioner has lost his passport in Germany and he has applied for renewal of the passport. He needs no objection from Passport Authorities in India to get renewed his passport.”
