Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.187 dated 24.9.2021 registered under Sections 61 of Excise Act at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in light of previous order dated 5.9.2022 passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court.

State counsel on instructions from SI Balkar Singh submits that indeed, the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery is already effected and now the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 5.9.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
