[1] On 12.10.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Present: Mr. Sunny Kumar Singla, Advocate for the petitioner.
Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 02.07.2023 registered under Sections 341, 342, 457, 380, 447, 511, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla.

Contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that co-accused Shingara Singh and the complainant are the co-sharers in the land in dispute. Attention for that matter is drawn towards towards jamabandi Annexure P.8. Learned counsel further contends that dispute regarding partition is pending before Court of Financial Commissioner (Revenue). Learned counsel further submits that interim anticipatory bail has already been granted to co-accused Sher Singh vide order dated 29.09.2023 passed in CRM-M-46548 of 2023. Learned counsel further submits that the only role attributed to the petitioner is that he was sitting on the tractor being driven by Achhra Singh. Learned counsel also submits that it is a case of no injury.

Adjourned to 20.12.2023.

In the meantime, in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner

shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

[2] Today, on instructions from ASI Harbax Singh, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 12.10.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[3] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 12.10.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.

[4] Disposed of.
