1. Petitioners in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeks the benefit of land pooling policy on account of the acquisition of their land which started in the year 2011 and culminated in 2014.

2. On 10.10.2022, the following order was passed:

“Mr.Sabherwal, states that the land pooling policy was framed in the year, 2019, whereas the land of the petitioner was acquired much before that and hence he was not entitled for the benefit.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks some time to have instructions in the matter.

Adjourned to 07.12.2022.”

3. Thereafter, on 22.02.2023, counsel for the petitioners took time to produce the relevant policy as would be applicable to them. Similar request was also made on 08.05.2023. Even today, counsel for the petitioners has not been able to place the policy in question on the basis of which he could claim any right.

4. Apparently, in the year 2019 compensation had also been given on account of the acquisition.
5. Faced with this situation, counsel is not in a position to press the present writ petition, at this stage, in the absence of any policy on the basis of which he can have any legal vested right. He accordingly prays that the present writ petition may be dismissed as withdrawn.
6. Ordered accordingly.
