The instant petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside and quashing the impugned order dated 18.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, whereby an application filed under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC by the petitioner has been dismissed.

On 08.08.2023, a request for adjournment was made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner and the case was adjourned to 15.09.2023. On 15.09.2023, following order was passed:
