As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants and the learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs. 2,70,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh and Seventy Thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, is ordered to be paid to the appellants as full and final settlement of their claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant no.1- Sarita.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a demand draft of Rs. 2,70,000/- (Rs. Two Lakh and Seventy Thousand only) in the name of the appellant no.1-Sarita in the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall accrue on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue a proper receipt to learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company, after receipt of the said demand draft. The appellant no.1/her counsel may collect the demand draft from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied to the counsel/parties and the file be returned to the High Court.

All pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
