This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 11.12.2014 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent, rejecting the claim of the petitioner with a costs of Rs.2500/-, as well as subsequent order dated 11.03.2015 (Annexure P-8), whereby petitioner's review application was dismissed. Further challenge is to the communication dated 09.03.2016 (Annexure P-10) asking the petitioner to deposit the costs.
