ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, at the outset, submits that pursuant to the representation submitted by the petitioner to the Municipal Council, Zirakpur, as also the Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar (Mohali), qua her concerns and grievances, the Additional Deputy Commissioner had sought necessary clarification/information from Municipal Commissioner, Zirakpur. He, however, points out that the petitioner had even earlier approached this Court vide CWP-25937-2018, based on the same cause of action, which is pending for 18.08.2023, but the fact regarding pendency of the said petition has not been disclosed in the present case. Be that as it may, he submits that Municipal Council, Zirakpur, has since submitted its report and now the matter is under active consideration of the Additional Deputy Commissioner. And, the necessary/appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed, at the earliest, and communicated to the petitioner.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner is agreeable to the course suggested by the learned State counsel.

In the wake of the above, the petition is disposed of, in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties.
