By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C for seeking the issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to enquire/investigate into the allegations levelled by her against respondents No.4 to 6 in the complaint/application Annexure P-1, as moved by her to the police authorities.

2. Mr. Gurlal Singh Dhillon, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Veena Rani from Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana, he informs the Court that the inquiry has already been conducted in respect of the complaint (Annexure P-1) as moved by the petitioner and since the offence under Section 323

IPC only, is found to have been committed in the case and the same is non-cognizable, therefore, the FIR has not been registered and rather, the DDR bearing No.21 dated 28.04.2023, has been entered in respect thereof.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that the petitioner would avail the appropriate, alternative and efficacious remedy, as may be permissible to her under law, to seek the redressal of her grievance as set-forth in the present petition.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
