Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner appeared in the Common Eligibility Test in pursuance to the notification dated 05.05.2022 (Annexure P-1 and as per the criteria mentioned in the notification, for the experience of 3 years and 8 months, he was entitled for 2 marks, which have not been given due to which the petitioner is suffering prejudice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the claim raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner through a representation dated 27.07.2023, which was registered at diary No.2338. Thereafter, the petitioner also sent an e-mail to the respondents raising the said grievance attaching the representation once again and copy of the said e-mail is also appended as Annexure P-9, hence, the respondents are under obligation to redress the grievance of the petitioner as raised vide representation, which has been received by the respondents vide diary No.2338 on 27.07.2023.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana who is present in Court, accepts notice for the respondents and submits that in case the representation,

which has been received by the respondents vide diary No.2338 on 27.07.2023, is not already decided, the same will be decided by the concerned authority by passing an appropriate speaking order on the same within a period of two weeks from today and by passing the said order, in case the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a further period of one week.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
