The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions to learned trial Court to decide/conclude the complaint moved by the petitioner under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is aged about 72 years and had earlier approached this Court by way of filing of CRWP No.1405 of 2023, however, the said petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 26.06.2023 with liberty to avail her alternative remedy, in accordance with law. Thereafter, the petitioner had filed a complaint (Annexure P-7) before the learned Illaqa Magistrate, Amritsar, which came up for hearing before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar on 13.06.2023 and a status report was ordered to be called from the concerned Police Station for 08.08.2023. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is

aged about 72 years and had approached different forums, seeking similar

relief, so appropriate directions may be issued to the learned trial Court to expedite the proceedings pending before it.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court to decide the complaint (Annexure P-1) expeditiously.
