The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents to take action against the responsible officers who were allegedly involved in the illegal appointment of a candidate possessing fake certificate of educational qualification to the post of Anganwari Worker.

Written statement on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 through Heman Sharma, Director, Women and Child Development Department, Haryana, has been filed as per which the matter was examined departmentally and was also referred to the police for investigation

whereupon FIR No.15 dated 17.01.2012 had been registered at Police Station, Agroha under Sections 420/468/467/471 of the IPC and upon conclusion of the investigation, the officials namely Sushila Rawal, Programme Officer, Hisar and Kusum Malik, CDPO were found innocent. The beneficiary is Suman Devi who is facing trial.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on last two dates successively. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present case.

The above written statement had been filed on 04.07.2018 and no rejoinder controverting any averment contained therein has also been filed.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
