Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the revised merit list, the petitioner was re-allocated the department of Mines and Geology for appointment as Clerk and the petitioner, who had already been appointed in the Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Haryana, was retired from the said post on 04.08.2022 and even after the expiry of more than one year the petitioner is not being allowed to join in the department of Mines and Geology on the ground that there is an interim order passed by this Court though, the said interim order was not continued by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made several representations to the respondents and the latest representation is dated 26.06.2023, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-12 with the petition and the petitioner will be satisfied, at

this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 26.06.2023 (Annexure P-12) is still pending consideration with the department, the same will be disposed of in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from today by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the passing of the speaking order, any benefit is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him expeditiously without any delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
