In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they were working with various Panchayat Samitis and were entitled for regularization of their services keeping in view the policies which have been issued by the Government of Punjab, which are applicable upon the Panchayat Samitis.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that a fresh policy has been issued by the Government of Punjab in the month of May, 2023 under which, the claim of the petitioners for regularization of their services is covered hence, the respondents are under obligation to consider

the claim of the petitioners for regularization of their services under the policies, which have come into operation after the appointment of the petitioners and pass an appropriate order.

Learned State counsel submits that the claim being raised by the petitioners will be considered under the policy which has been issued by the Government now on 16.05.2023 and appropriate order qua the entitlement of the petitioners for regularization of their services will be passed keeping in view the terms and conditions of the said policy dated 16.05.2023. The said order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioners are found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to them without their being any further delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives and the present petition may be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
