On 07.08.2023, following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a lady of the age of 33 years and even otherwise also as per the allegations her role was only to the extent of instigation. He further submitted that the complainants are father and son and they have left India and they are residing abroad.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State and prays for some time to seek instructions and to file affidavit in the present case.

Adjourned to 11.12.2023.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and on her doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Status report by way of an affidavit of Shri Kanwalpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Majitha, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of respondent- State.

Today learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jitender Singh, submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 07.08.2023 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
