HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the candidates, who had lesser marks in the Common Eligibility Test, have been called for written examination to be held on 05/06.08.2023, which written examination is being held in pursuance to the Advertisement dated 07.03.2023, the candidates having lesser marks than the petitioner are being considered, which is arbitrary and illegal.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per his instructions, the candidates have been called for written test according to their merit and in case the petitioner submit that anyone who has lesser

merit than him in the Common Eligibility Test, has been called for written test and the said name is supplied to the Commission, the said grievance will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of one week on any such representation is filed by the petitioner.

5. Keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation with the Commission disclosing the name of the candidate who had been called for written test, who had lesser marks than him in the Common Eligibility Test so that the said grievance can be considered by the Commission.
