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The matter has again been discussed with the learned
counsel for the parties in detail and they have arrived at a settlement.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the
appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately
recorded, a sum of Rs.28,00,000/- over and above the amount already
awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned
counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to
legal representatives 1 to 4-Balkar Singh, Swaranjeet Kaur, Ranjeet
Kaur, Dalvara Singh, children of Ajmer Singh in equal shares, in full &
final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit four cheques in the sum of
Rs.7,00,000/- each (Rs.28,00,000/- in total) favouring legal
representatives 1 to 4-Balkar Singh, Swaranjeet Kaur, Ranjeet Kaur,
Dalvara Singh, children of Ajmer Singh, with the Office of the Lok
Adalat of the High Court within six weeks from today. Failing
compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this
amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants'
counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok
Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheques/drafts
bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
