The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 25.02.2022 passed in CRM-M-8110-2022, vide which, without advertent to merits of the case, petition was disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the complaints, as per law.

As per compliance affidavit of Chairman, Punjab State Commission for NRIs, Chandigarh, by passing the speaking orders dated 05.05.2022 and 22.05.2023, both the complaints have been decided.
