[1] Challenge in the instant petition is to judgment dated 06.08.2009 passed by the learned Appellate Authority upholding order dated 18.01.2006 passed by the learned Rent Controller, Barnala dismissing the ejectment petition filed by the petitioners landlords.

[2] Learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. Dhruv Mittal, Advocate contends that during the pendency of the instant petition, the parties have entered into an amicable settlement and the shop in question has been sold by the petitioners to the wife of respondent- No.1/tenant vide sale deed dated 16.01.2023, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned Counsel, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
