HAR PIYARI & ORS V/S HARENDER KUMAR & ORS

On 20.12.2022, the following order was passed:-

“After discussion, it is stated by Mr. Shiv Hari, one of the appellants that if an amount of Rs.4,50,000/- is paid over and above the amount already awarded by learned MACT (i.e. Rs.2,91,600/-), this appeal can be disposed of.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 13.01.2023.

Copy of the order be supplied to the representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company.

The previous order dated 01.12.2022 passed by us stands corrected.”

Mr. Shiv Hari appellant No.2 was present. He signed the consent agreement, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.4,50,000/-(Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal. He stated that agreed amount be released in favour of appellant No.

1. It is further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other

appellant(s), the appellant No. 1 shall indemnify the said claimant(s).

Mr. Nigam K. Bhardwaj, Advocate for the respondent No.3-Insurance Company has also signed the said statement today accepting the proposal made by appellant No.2-Shiv Hari.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.4,50,000/-(Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) favouring appellant No. 1-Har Piyari wd/o Sh. Tek Chand with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 24.03.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
