This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the impugned order dated 03.07.1960 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.3 vide which respondent No.3 had declared 24.68 standard acre of land of late Sh. Wazir Singh as surplus under the Punjab Security of Land Tenures Act, 1953, with a further prayer for directing respondent No.3 to decide the objections dated 27.08.2021 and 16.09.2021 (Annexures P-3 & P-4).

On 28.10.2021, Co-ordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners confines his prayer to issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the objections filed against order of declaration of surplus area and order of entry of

mutation based thereupon within a time bound manner.
