MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to decide the application dated 29.09.2018 moved by petitioner under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 and also to pay compensation *qua* his share in the acquired land, in view of judgment dated 30.04.2018 (P-1) passed by this Court in RFA No. 3719 of 2015.

2. At the outset, learned State Counsel, while making reference to para-3 of the affidavit dated 07.07.2020 of Sh. M.L. Goyal, Executive Engineer Provincial Division, PWD B&R Branch, Panchkula, submits that the above application has been rejected by the competent authority; thus grievance of the petitioner has been redressed and present petition be disposed off as having been rendered

infructuous. For reference, relevant para-3 of the above affidavit reads as under:-

“ That the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous in view of the fact that the prayer of the petitioner to decide the application submitted u/s 28A of the Land Acquisition Act dated 29.09.2018 received in the office of answering respondent on 04.10.2018 and the same has been rejected being time barred on 29.11.2019. Therefore, the prayer of the petitioner is already fulfilled and the present writ petition has become infructuous. A copy of the report submitted by Kanogone to Land Acquisition Officer is also signed by Land Acquisition Officer dated 29.11.2019 is attached herewith as Annexure R-1. ”

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed off as having rendered infructuous.

Needless to say that in case the petitioner feels aggrieved, he may move appropriate application for recalling of this order and same shall be considered in accordance with law.
