1. The petitioner through instant petitioner under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider claim of the petitioner for her seniority/promotion at par with other employees.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that

Bhawna Upadhaya filed Civil Writ Petition No.1285 of 2012 before Delhi High Court seeking seniority. The said petition came to be allowed vide order dated 03.04.2013.

3. The respondent applying said judgment prepared fresh seniority list in 2013, 2014 and thereafter in 2019. The judgment of Delhi High Court has been implemented *qua* others and juniors of the petitioner have been promoted whereas petitioner has not been granted benefit of judgment of Delhi High Court.

4. On being confronted with aforesaid fact, learned counsel for the respondents submits that grievance of the petitioner would be looked into and appropriate order *qua* seniority/promotion of the petitioner considering judgment of Delhi High Court would be passed within four weeks from today.

5. The petition stands disposed of in view of statement of learned counsel for the respondents.
